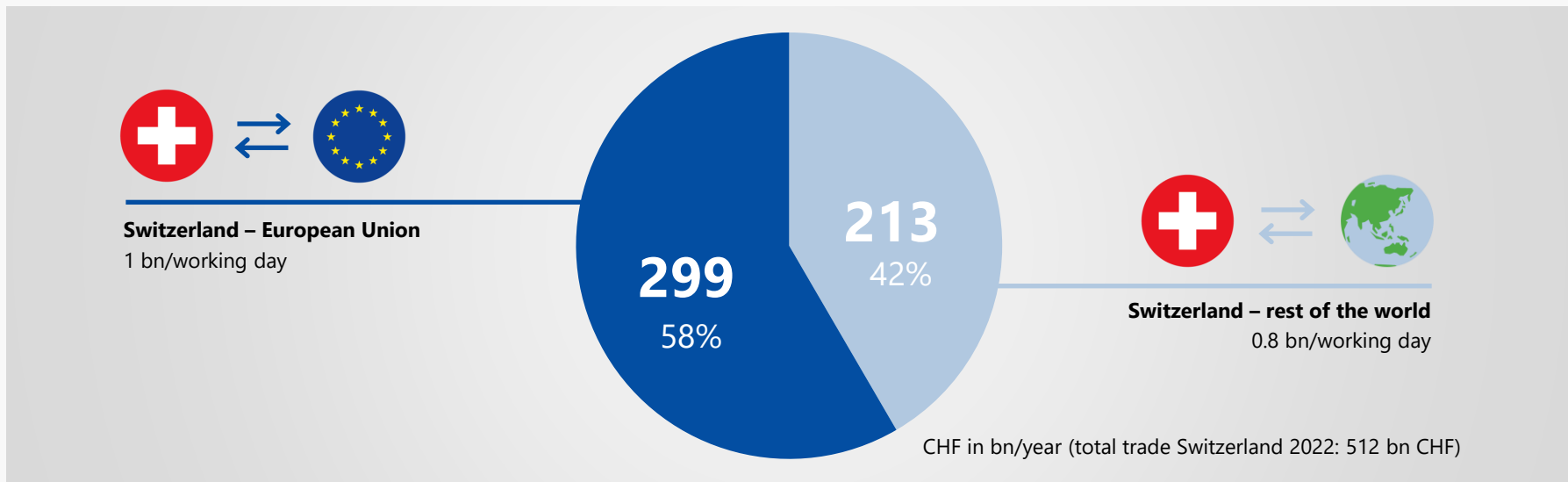

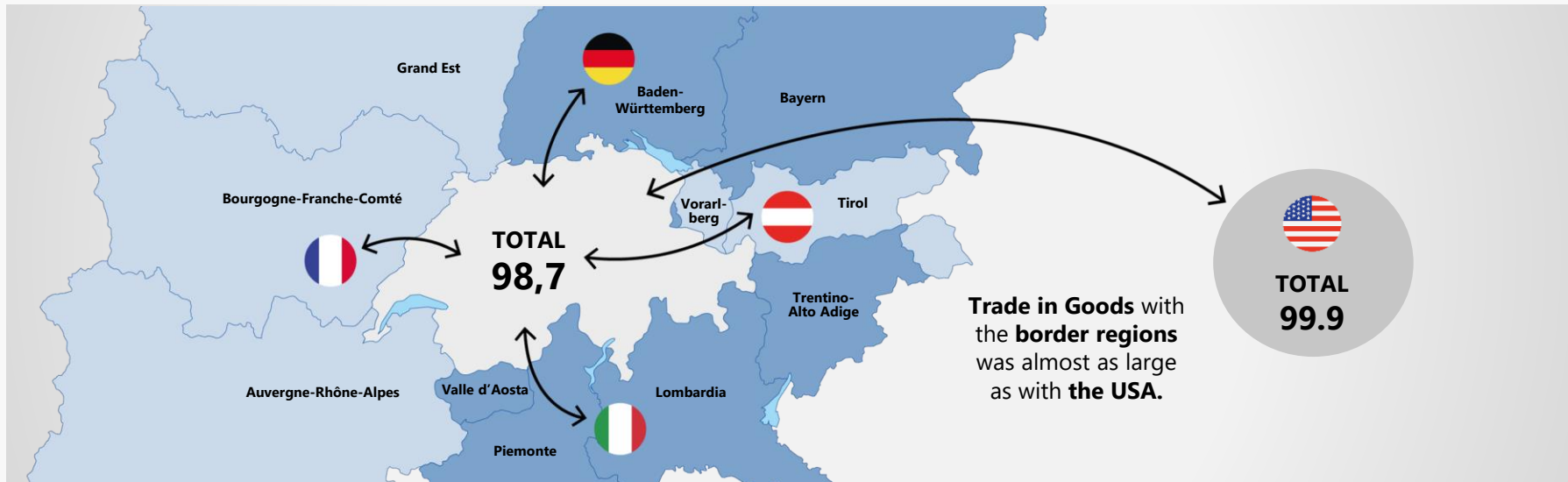
The EU: Switzerland's most important partner



Switzerland's volume of trade in 2021 in bn CHF/year. Source: Swiss-Impex (Total 1)



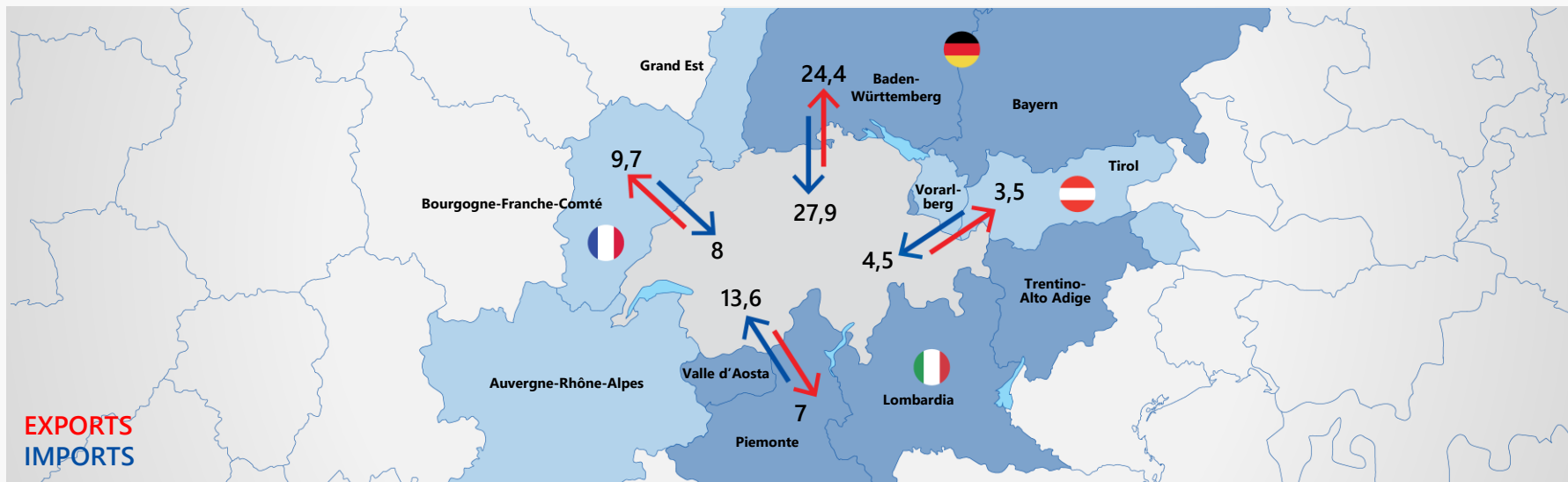
Extensive trade with border regions



Switzerland's volume of trade in 2022 in bn CHF/year. Source: Swiss-Impex (Total 2) and Swiss embassies in neighbouring countries.



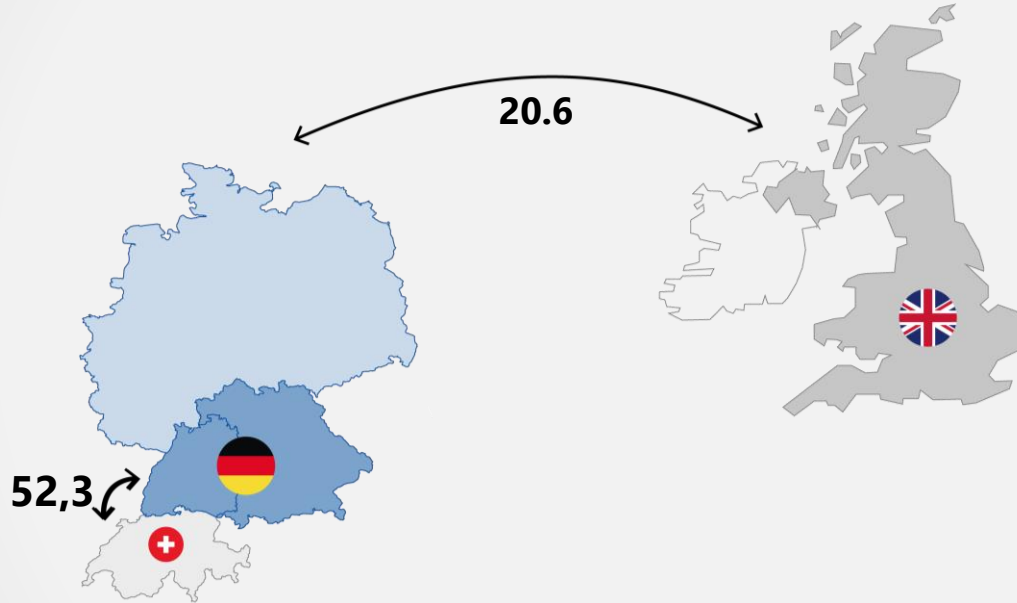

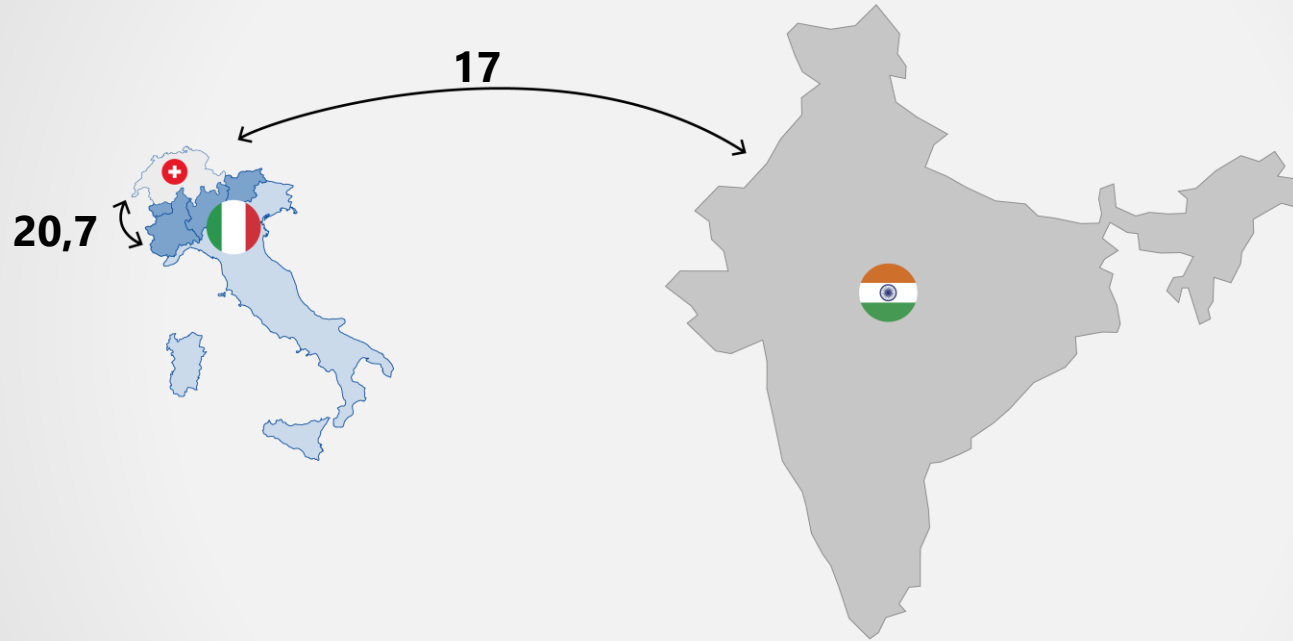

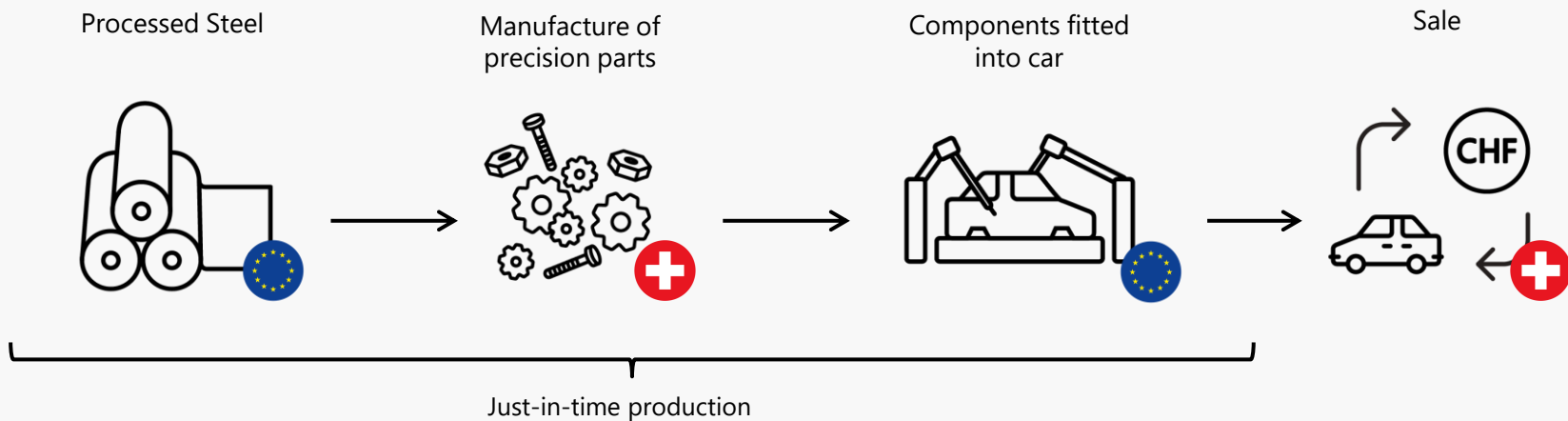
1 day with EU = 1 year with Indonesia



Volume of trade in 2021 in bn CHF. Source: Swiss-Impex (Total 1)

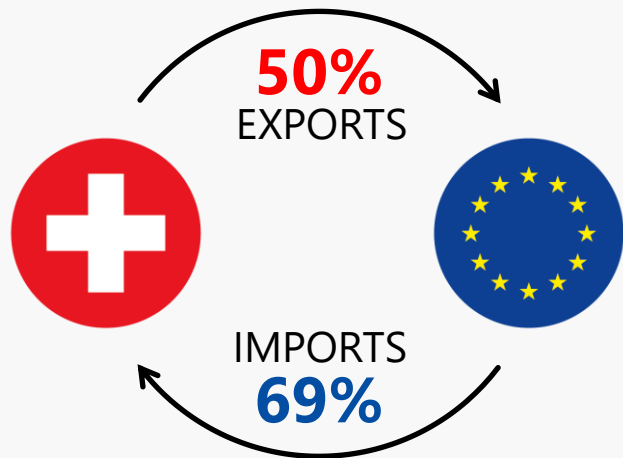


Automobile value chain

Switzerland–EU: a win-win relationship



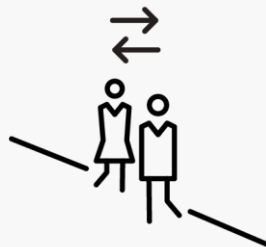
Trade

Switzerland was the EU's fourth largest trading partner in 2022, after the US, China, and the UK (third in services)

Mobility

About 458,000 Swiss citizens live in the EU and around 1.5 million EU citizens live in Switzerland

More than 370,000 workers cross the border into Switzerland every day



Swiss investments in the EU

CHF 614 billion invested in the EU (2022)

Switzerland is the third biggest investor in the EU after the US and the UK



Emerging and future technologies

Switzerland supplies important components for the development of future technologies such as high-performance computers
